

## **Annual Marriage Rates Down**


1970-2010

#### % of women ages 40-44





# of remarriages per 1,000 divorced or widowed (ages 18+)




# Higher Mean Age at First Marriage--Men



# Higher Mean Age at First Marriage---Women




# Higher Mean Age of Women at Birth of First Child

1960-2014


#### Lifetime average # of children per woman

1970-2010


#### % of all births


- Less stigma

#### Percentile of Annual Earnings Distribution




# Winners and Losers under US Tax Code



#### **Couples Without Children**






#### Household Income and Benefits Chart





### Marginal Tax Rates if Moving from Welfare to Work


Single Mothers with Two Children in 2013
